Aristarkh Lentulov

(4 January 1882 – 15 April 1943)

Was a major Russian avant-garde artist of Cubist orientation who also worked on set designs for theatre. Lentulov formed an art group, Segodnyashnii Lubok (Today's Lubok), which took inspiration from Russian folklore and lubok art, a popular print.

Lentulov's art was heavily inspired by traditional and folk Russian architecture.
